Karl Diacono read Management Studies at Anglia University, attaining a Master of Science in 1999, and is a Member of the Malta Institute of Management, as well as a Founding Member of Caravaggio Foundation

Mr. Diacono has worked in the catering industry, within the management department, and is currently involved as a shareholder and director of a family restaurant. He has also had experience in sales management within the hospitality sector, with NSTS Student and Youth Travel and thereafter with Ta' Monita Ltd, a family-owned holiday complex.

In 1993, Mr. Diacono joined BDS Ltd, an IT organization, as Sales Manager, and, within a short period of time, made the company the leading local supplier of IT solutions to the hospitality industry, winning over other leading players in the local industry.

Since 1998, Mr. Diacono has been with Fenech & Fenech Advocates as Director of Administration of the law firm and overseeing operations of associated service companies.

In the mean time, he was also appointed as a Director of Sclavo Diagnostics International, a company based in Italy, producing and distributing reagents.

Since 2001, Mr. Diacono has additionally been responsible for the management of a portfolio of properties in London and Malta. He also formed part of a team of four persons who organised 'Caravaggio, Una Mostra Impossibile' held at Carafa Stores in Birgu between May and June of 2004 - an event with 10 international scholars giving lectures on Caravaggio, 23 musical performances and a number of art exhibitions by local artists.

In 2005, Mr. Diacono strongly contributed to the setting up of Impetus Europe Consulting Group and is the Managing Director of the company.
